Teen Clinic at Vincent Massey Collegiate (VMC)

We offer Teen Clinic services to students at Vincent Massey Collegiate in Winnipeg. During the school year, VMC students can drop in to the school clinic between 11am - 3pm on Monday or Friday. During July and August, they can come to Women's Health Clinic, 3rd Floor, 419 Graham Avenue.
