Position Summary:

The Communications Graphic Designer is responsible for designing and implementing graphic design products for WHC, including but not limited to: posters, pamphlets, banners, social media icons and graphics, sponsorship packages, and the Annual Report. This position is responsible for managing the workflow of requests for products, maintaining databases of design and communication work, updating the WHC website, and advising on organizational brand standards.

Requirements:

The ideal candidate is a self-motivated, organized and detail-oriented individual. The successful candidate will possess excellent analytical, verbal and written communication skills and be able to work to strict deadlines while contributing to a professional working environment.

Candidates must have:

- Post-secondary education and/or demonstrated experience in graphic design.
- Demonstrated proficiency with Adobe Creative Suite (specifically InDesign, Photoshop, and Illustrator),
 and strong MS Office Skills (specifically Word, Excel, Outlook and PowerPoint).
- Familiarity with web-based marketing programs such as Mail Chimp and Constant Contact
- MUST be legally able to work in Canada
- Satisfactory Criminal Record check, Adult Abuse Registry and Child Abuse Registry check
