**Position Summary:**

- Canadian Medical Protective Association (member in good standing) or acceptable alternate)
- Demonstrated computer proficiency
- Minimum of 2 to 3 years' experience in a community health setting
- Basic Cardiac Life Support (BCLS) certification
- MUST be legally able to work in Canada
- Satisfactory Criminal Record check and Child Abuse Registry check
